The caterpillar are now in their cocoons so it won't be very long before the butterflies emerge. We will be using some ICT equipment and water play and messy tuff trays too.




We will do a collage of the village showing where we went on our walk and what we saw. Items brought in for Show and Tell should start with the sound "a".
